THANKS to the congregation for the generous end of year giving. We were able to pay all our expenses for 2010 including 100% of our Apportionments (FRUMC's tithe to the United Methodist Conference). We thought this year we would post updates in the Tower Notes to keep you apprised of the churches finances. January had five Sundays so the average for the month was slightly above budget for giving. We also dodged any Sundays missed by bad weather. Let's hope February is as forgiving. Some of our expenses last month included the conference apportionment payment of \$5895.00 and the district apportionment of \$780.00. Property expenses cost \$7818.00 and were you aware that the churches insurance alone costs over \$20,000 for a year. Last month committees spent \$1700.00 and office expenses were \$1163.00. Plus we have to pay the salaries of all the folks who keep these programs and building operating. Again, thank you for the continued financial support of FRUMC.

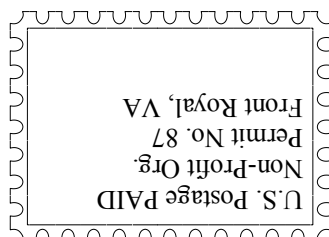
Donna Quarton's Birthday March 21st
