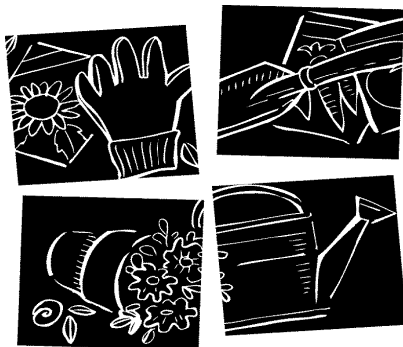

Our “**Power of Two**” policy simply states that no child be left alone anywhere in the church or on a church related activity. 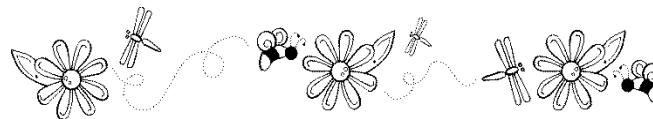
