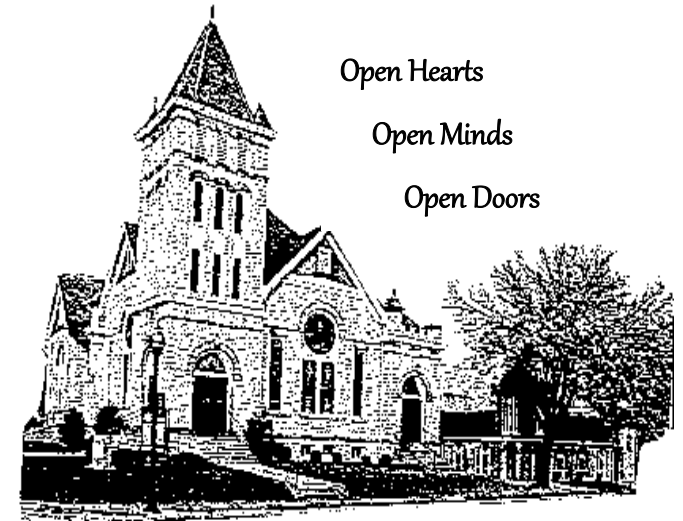

Please remember when you hear or know of a member of our church family who is hospitalized to please call the church office and let the pastor know.

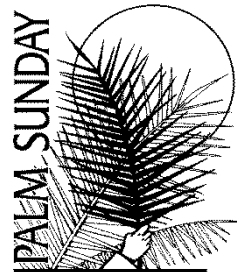
