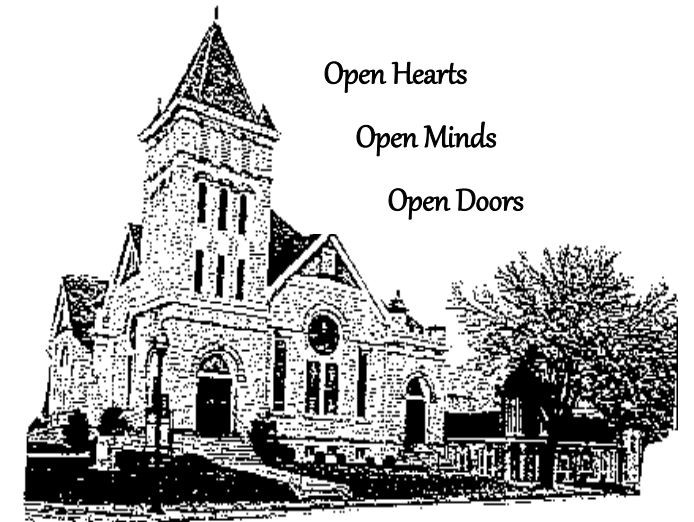

Smart Driver Safety Program – AARP is conducting an all-day classroom smart driver safety refresher course on Wednesday, October 12th, for those 50 and over, at FRUMC. Certificates will be given to those who complete the course, which should make drivers eligible for a multi-year discount on their vehicle insurance. Participants will learn defensive driving techniques, new traffic laws and rules of the road to compensate for age-related changes. It will be an all-day class with a one-hour lunch break, and drivers are invited to bring a brown bag lunch to class. The course is sponsored by the "Free Spirits", the church's ministry for seniors, as well as the UMM. \$20 covers the cost of materials, and AARP members will receive a \$5 discount.
